

ADMISSION INTERVIEWS FOR  
ALUMNI FAMILY MEMBERS  
Policy Revised 5/17/06

The University of Maryland School of Pharmacy Admissions Committee has established the following policy:

Any applicant to the Doctor of Pharmacy who has a parent, grandparent, or sibling that is a University of Maryland School of Pharmacy alumnus will be interviewed by the admissions administrator. The results of this interview will be included in the applicant's portfolio for consideration by the admissions committee. This policy does not guarantee admission into the program. Admission decisions are based on several factors including prior academic performance, Pharmacy College Admission Test (PCAT) scores, and the results of the admission interview. This policy does guarantee an admissions interview.

This policy will be instituted with the 1996-7 admissions cycle. Alumni family members must identify themselves to the admissions committee in order to take part in the interview.
