### **Policy**

PharmD students must possess and maintain 1) a working laptop meeting the School's minimum laptop and software specifications (<http://www.pharmacy.umaryland.edu/pharmdlaptop>) and 2) reliable residential and/or public broadband internet access. Required software must be installed before announced deadlines. Participation in certain courses requires installation of applications such as Exemplify for examinations, NeehrPerfect for Electronic Health Record (EHR) activities, and WebLock for PCOA.

A student's inability to stream lectures or access web-based course materials is not an acceptable reason for missing or poor performance on assignments. Unwillingness to install required software may lead to course failure or an honor code violation. If a student encounters technical difficulties installing required software they may be granted a technology accommodation for a specific duration. Course syllabi and their associated policies outline limited circumstances in which a technology accommodation may be granted.
